England & GB Hockey is a large organisation with operations and activities spanning the UK, and its technology needs are wide ranging. The challenge they faced was to efficiently and securely meet the needs of staff, players, coaches, around 30 sponsors, suppliers and partners, as well as thousands of volunteers while playing at home in the UK, or away across the globe.

Mobile data has been an essential element in making the organisation a very connected one; with 140,000 people playing each weekendin matches and competitions, the results need tobe recorded and managed. Instead of having to send in paper based results which then need to be collated, mobile data has enabled all match results to be sent in via connected smartphones and tablets, saving time and resource and streamlining the process significantly. O2 has played a pivotal role in supporting England & GB Hockey in other areas of their business, deploying technology to aid communication with coaches and players in the UK and wherever they might need to beplaying and training across the globe, assisting their video analysts who work closely with players in training, and the general business of staff working with clubs and schools.

As an organisation they were aware of the potential vulnerability of technology systems which were managing a large amount of sensitive and detailed data about their players and customers.

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Technology plays a really important role for England Hockey on a day to day basis, O2 provides us with technology right the way across the business.
